Conclusions:

- The newer midwives are part of the chapter, but we need to work on membership > 5 Years out.
- 87% are Masters prepared and work full time (40+ hours/week) and most of us provide full scope midwifery.
- 1/3 of us DO NOT precept midwifery students but more revealing is that more than 50% of respondents precept NPs, PAs or residents!
- Most of us do a little of both admin and clinical.

Cont.

- 81% are in non-union positions & 67% would consider joining a union.
- Salaries range from \$80K- \$120K (for the majority of respondents) and everyone gets perks. (4 weeks vacation and 1 week educational time.
- Malpractice is paid for everyone and so are other license fee's (i.e. DEA)
- In NYC, we are doing well. We will F/U with a comparison to the workforce study at the ACNM.
